~ FPUSA PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS ~

This event will determine the U.S. Team for the Pan American 2011 Men's World Championship Qualifier.*

1. All participants must have been an FPUSA member since March 26th AND must not have been a member of any other Federation since 2006. Members who did not renew by March 26th are not eligible.
2. Each team must include at least 2 U.S. citizens by birth or naturalization. The 3rd member may be a non-citizen provided that he has not been a member of any other Federation since 2006, and he is in possession of official documentation showing that he is a resident of the United States.
3. Pre-Registration WITH FULL PAYMENT is required for this event *by the closing date* noted above.
4. *All players must sign the form below* verifying US Citizenship or Residency before the tournament begins. There will be no exceptions. If any contestant falsifies the Registration Form, he will be disqualified and will be suspended from participation in any FPUSA Title Tournament for a period of 3 years.
5. Every Participant must bring his Federation Card and can be asked to produce it before or during play.
6. Teams who do not qualify for the Sunday pools will be entered into the Federation Cup Tournament if they so choose at no extra cost. There is no penalty nor refund for declining participation in the Federation Cup.
7. **Winners have the honor and obligation to represent the U.S.A. at the 2011 Pan American World Championship Qualification Tournament.** (Please refer to FPUSA Bylaw regulations for more details.)

** To be held on October 1-2 at the Club or in the Region where the winning team resides, if there are more than two countries (in addition to US and Canada) who commit to participate. Otherwise, the winning team will qualify directly to represent the USA at the FIPJP Men's World Championship in Marseille, France in October, 2012.*

All players are required to wear team shirts of the same color and style for the entire competition.
